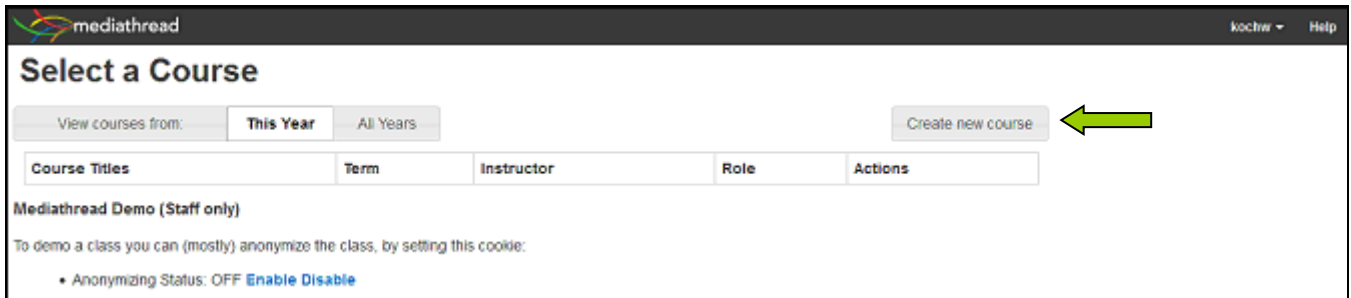


Figure 1 Creating a new course

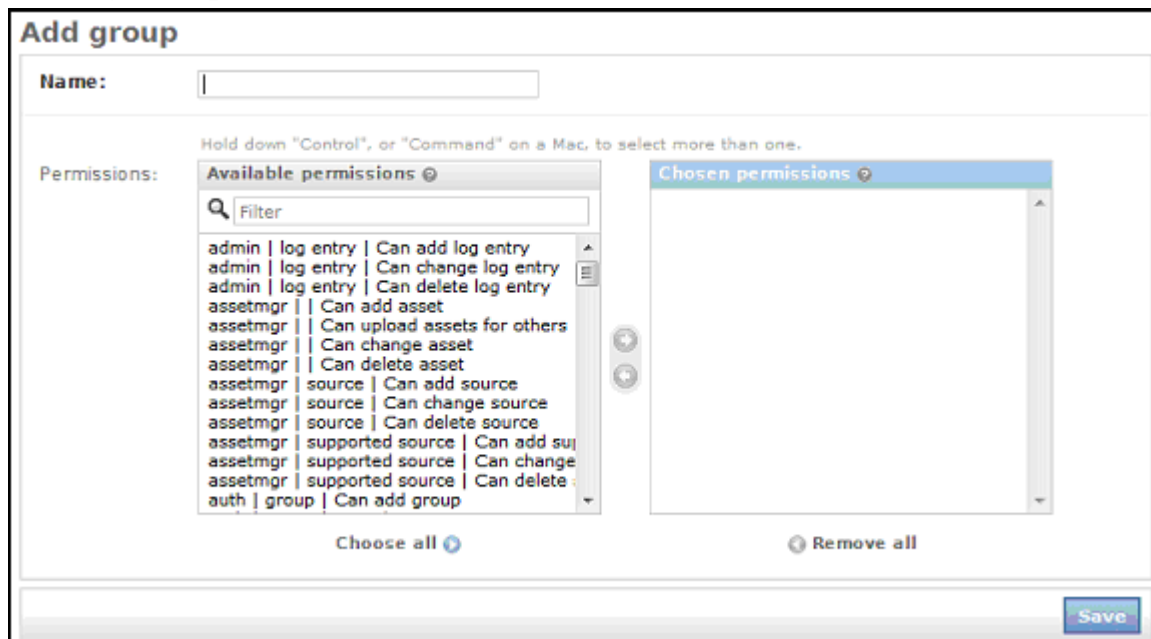


Figure 3 Adding group

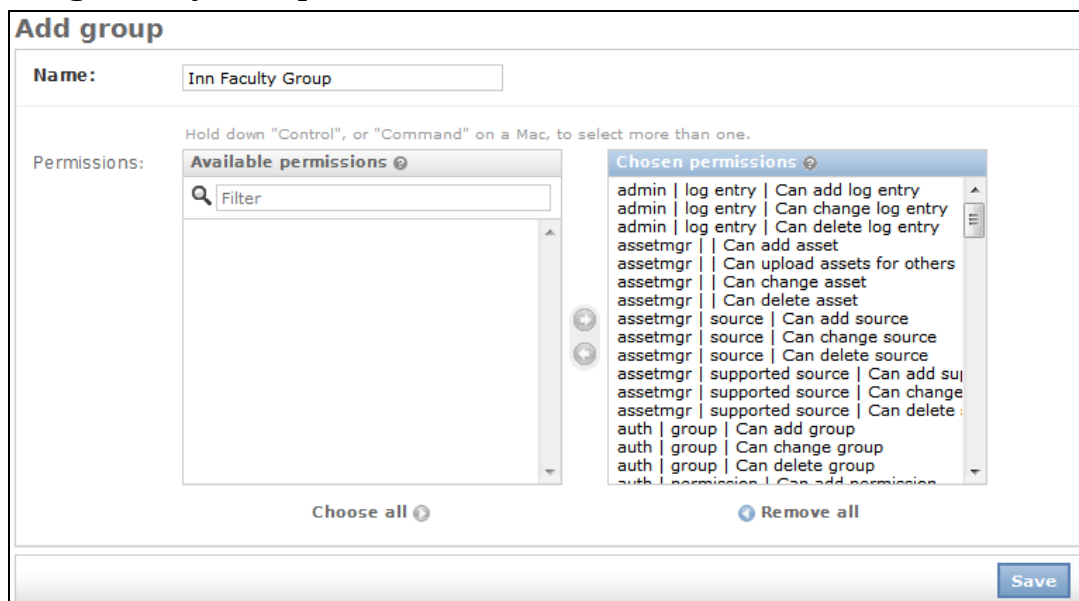


Figure 4 Adding Faculty Group




Figure 5 Adding users

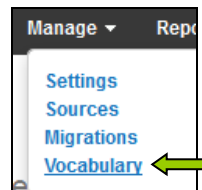


Figure 6 Clicking on "Vocabulary"




Figure 7 Adding a course vocabulary



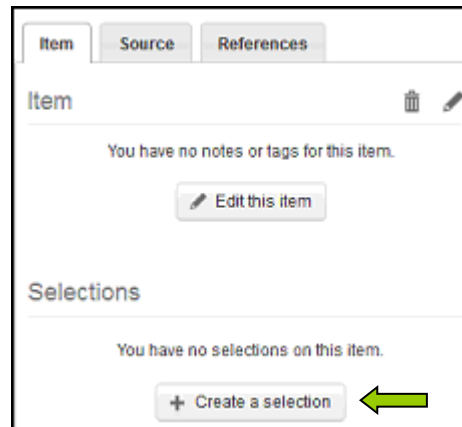


Figure 10 Create a selection

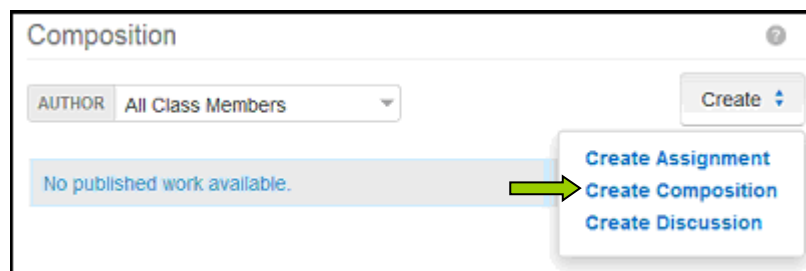


Figure 11 Creating a Composition

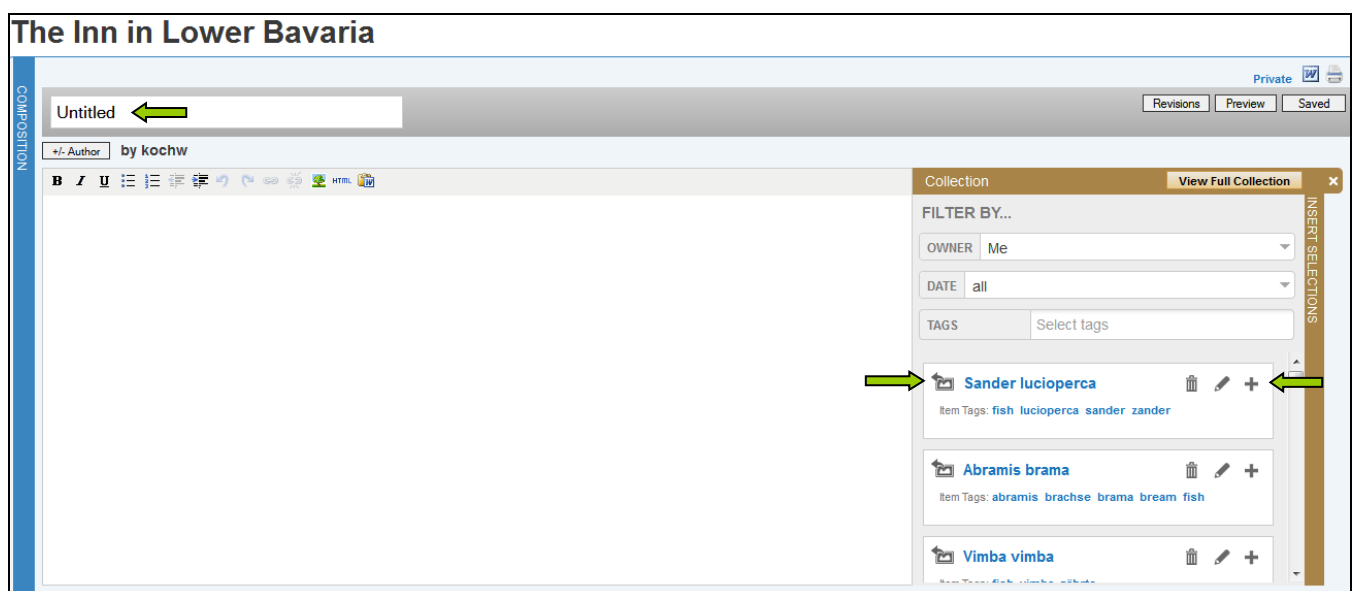


Figure 12 Adding a composition

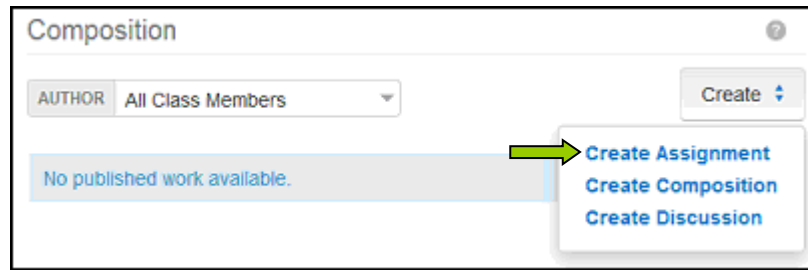


Figure 13 Creating an Assignment

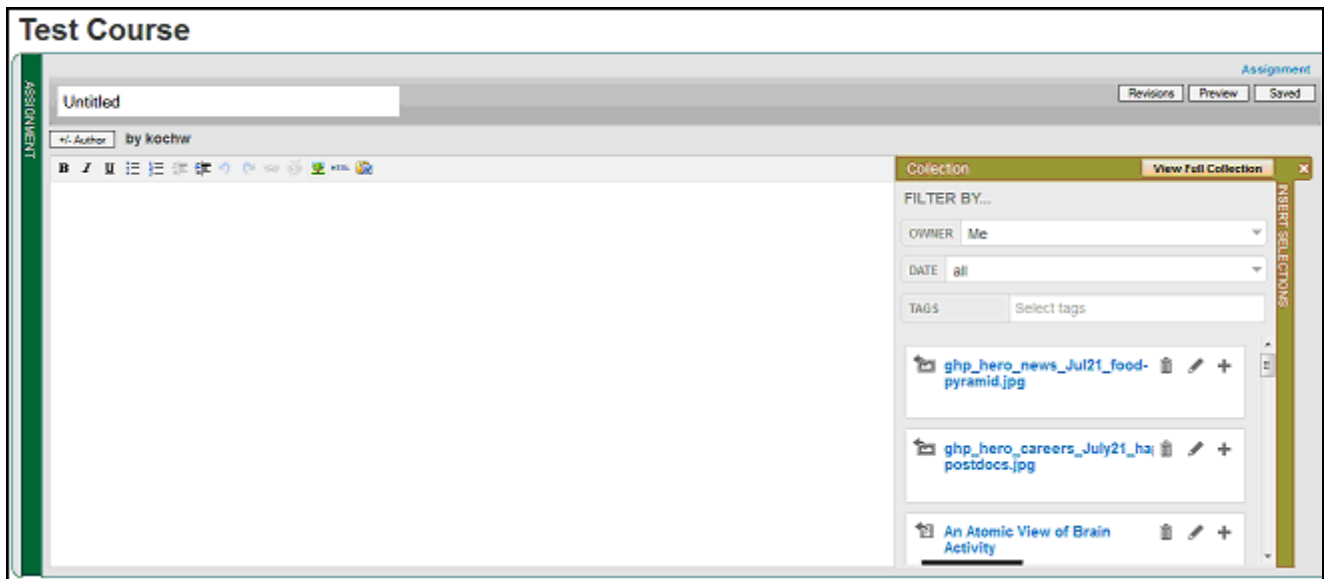


Figure 14 Adding an Assignment

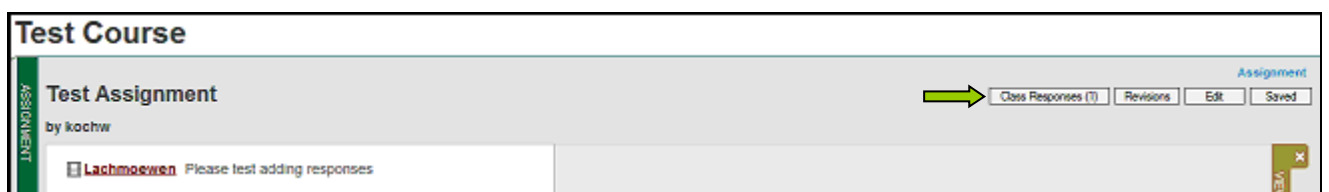


Figure 15 Opening the Class Responses

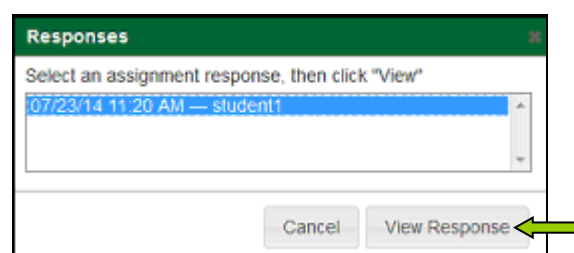


Figure 16 Viewing responses

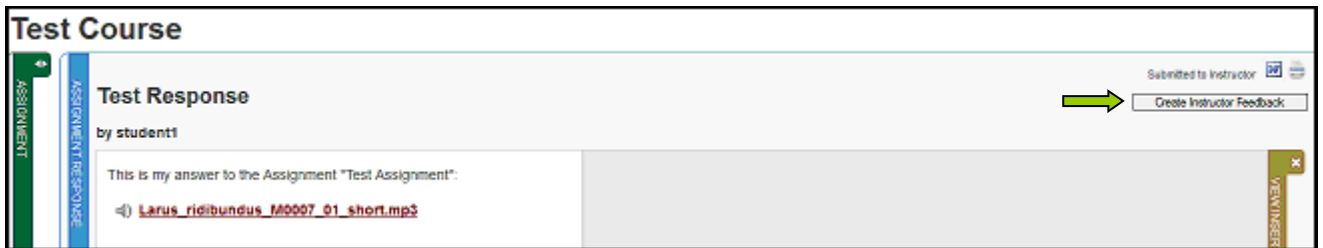


Figure 17 Creating Instructor Feedback

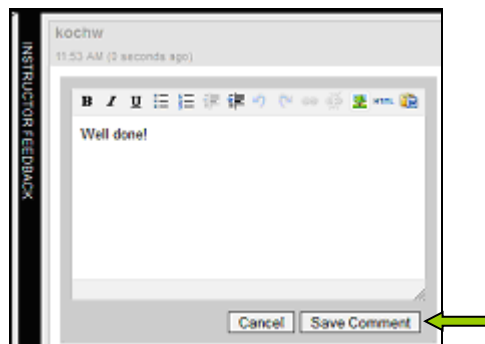


Figure 18 Saving comment

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
